«Bitumen and other stuff»

The traditional student exhibition will be presented by the second class of the design- section of the Geneva School of Arts.

Last year's design class put together a book concerning "Bitumen" (asphalt). This year's students have taken the same subject again but have examined it in the context "city". Last year's book was used as a basis for their work, and will be shown in their concept "Bitumen and other stuff" especially for Fumetto.

A series of screen-printed pieces were produced under the guidance of the screen-printing specialist Christian Humbert-Droz, the man behind Editions Drozophile. The theme of the exhibition should not only be reflected in this work, but should also be made through the production. Next to the screen-prints on the wall there will also be pictures projected onto screens. Some pieces will appear plastic-like (with the help of 3D glasses) and other objects portray the urban zone.

Apart from all this, the students have also set-up a small screen-printing workshop where visitors can try their hand (under supervision) at printing.

And to top the exhibition off, the students have organised a special autograph signing session on Friday the 7th of April in the "HGK" courtyard in Lucerne (Rössligasse 12).
